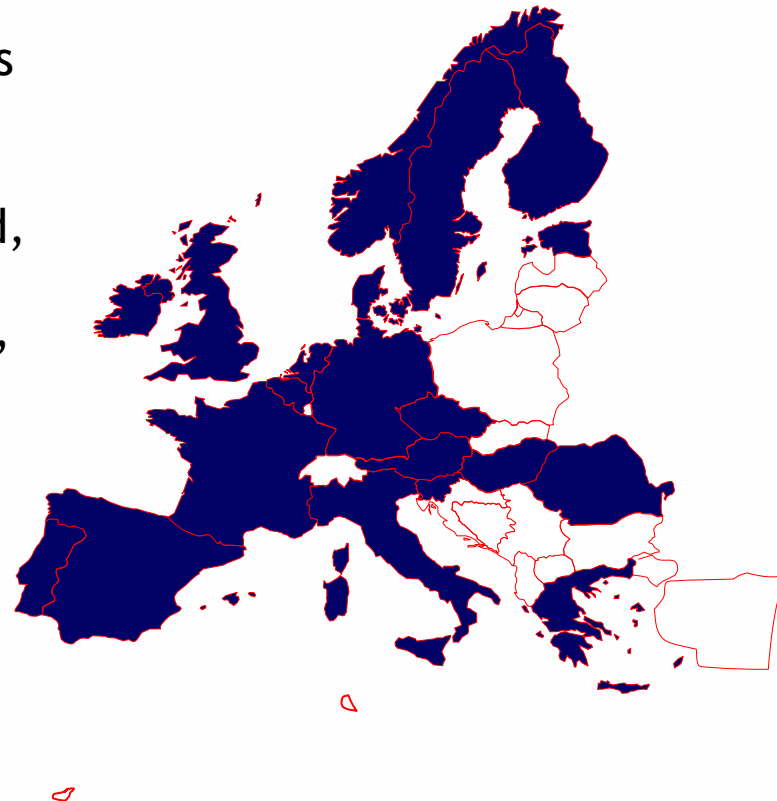

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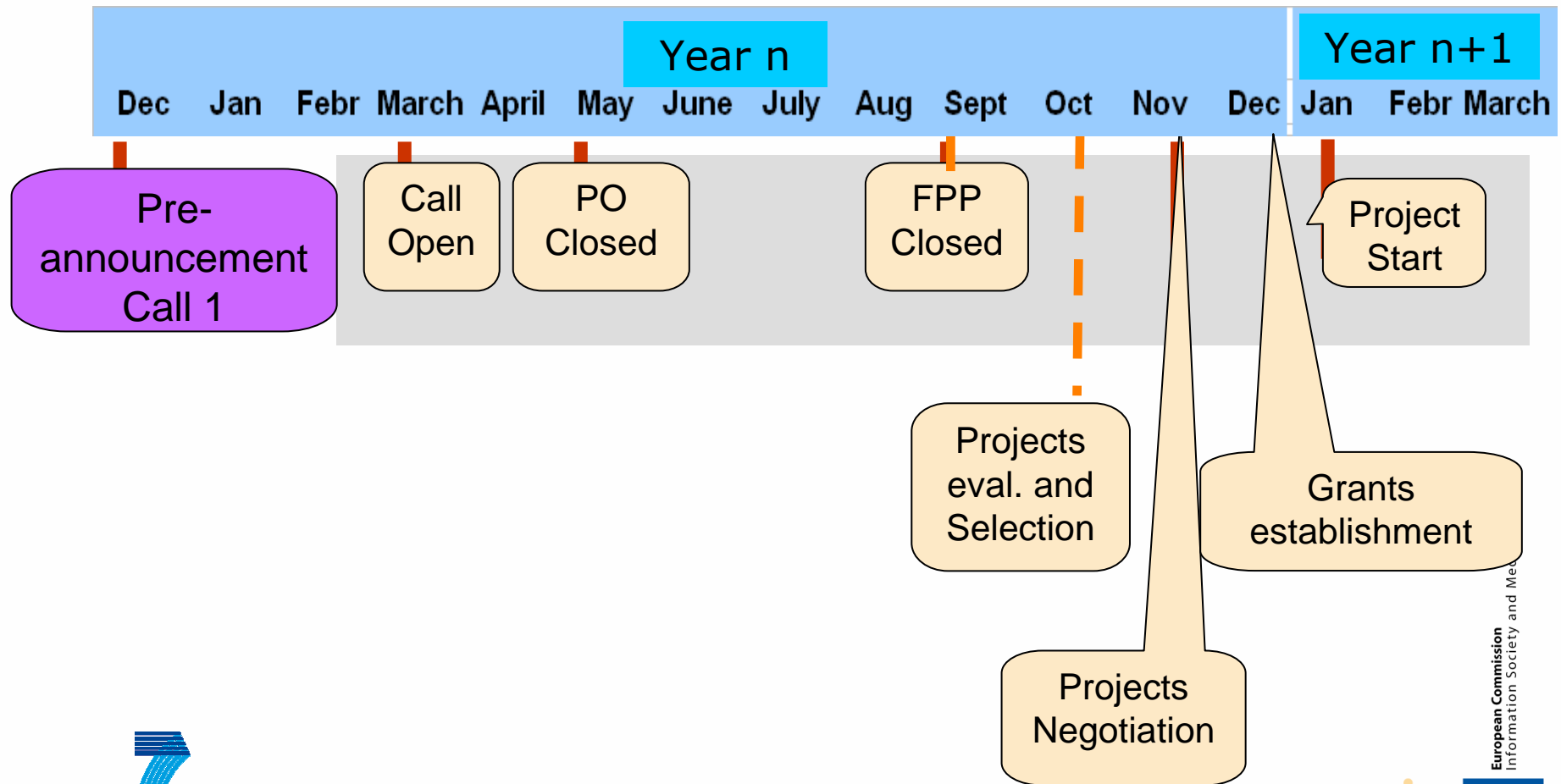

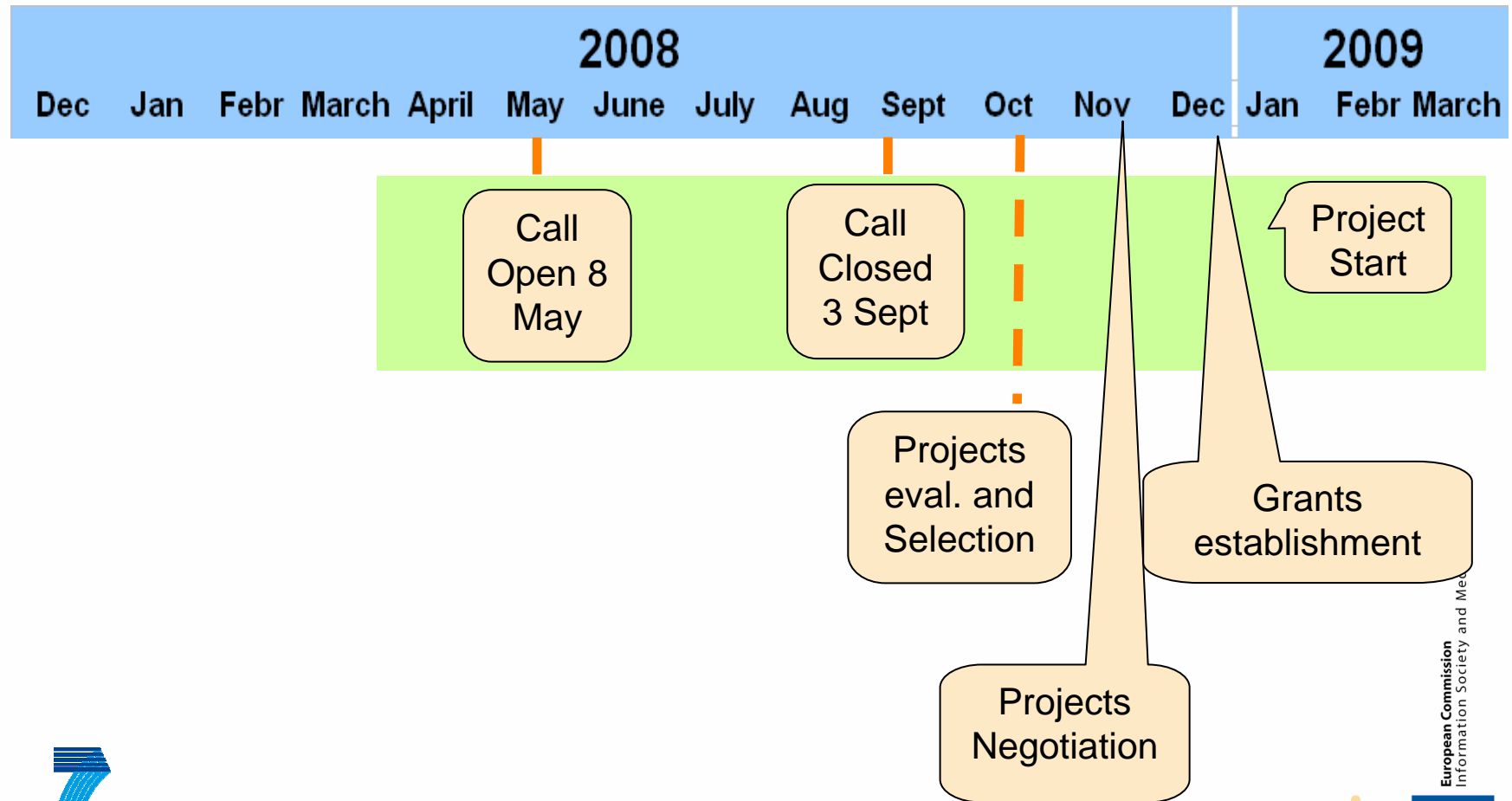

- **Build a consortium with minimum 3 independent legal entities from 3 ARTEMIS Member States**
- **Propose a collaborative R&D project in scope with the ARTEMIS Annual Work Programme (AWP)**
- **Check the Call text and info pack:**
 - Call text
 - Eligibility Criteria (JU and national funding)
 - Annual Work Programme (Content, Eval. Criteria)
 - Guide for applicants (Template for proposal, national and JU funding rates)
- **Use the ARTEMIS submission tool (APS)**

Preparing your proposal

- **Call text** (deadlines?)
- **Annual Work Programme** (Content, Eval. Criteria)
- **Eligibility Criteria** (JU and national)
 - Am I eligible for JU funding?

- **Selection done by Public Authorities Board (PAB)**
- **Evaluation criteria**
 - Relevance and contributions to the content and objectives of the Call
 - R&D innovation and technical excellence
 - S&T approach and work plan
 - Market innovation and impact
 - Quality of consortium and management

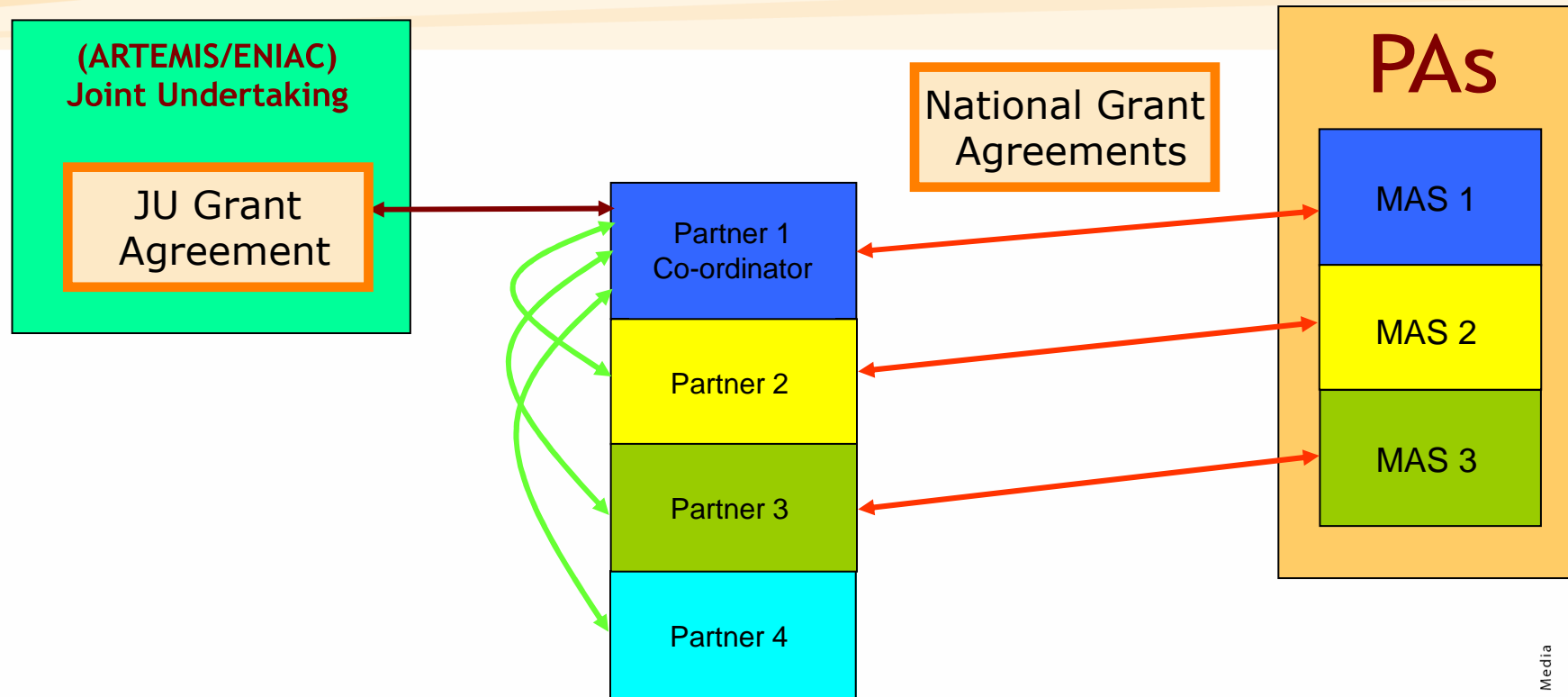
What happens next? Negotiation

- **Responsibility of the ARTEMIS JU Executive Director (EC in Call 2008)**
- **PAB gives a negotiation mandate**
- **If negotiations successful, grants agreements are established**
 - JU grant agreement
 - National grant agreement (no further evaluation/selection process)

Why JU Grant Agreement in addition to National Grant Agreements?

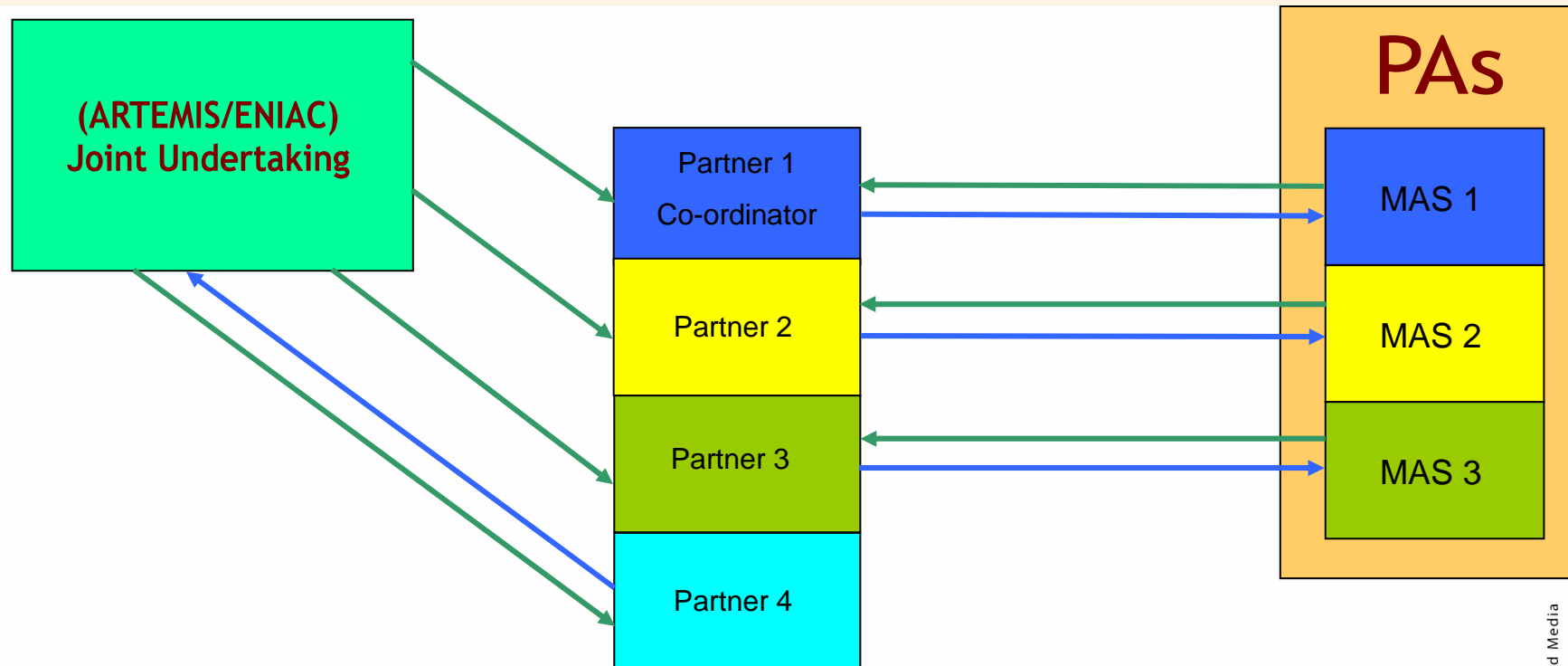
- Reception of Community funding
- Overall technical coherence of the project as well as the role of the technical co-ordinator
- No practical implications in the daily management of partners:
 - Single technical monitoring process at JU level
 - Single administrative request for both national and JU reimbursement of cost (JU automatic)

What's in it for me? (1/2)

- Participation for **Industry**
 - *R&D programme* driven by industry's priorities (SRA)
 - *An attractive funding regime with larger public budgets*
 - *Lower overheads for project delivery*, through single gateway access to funding and streamlined processes (compared to Eureka)
 - *Reduced time to market* for new products and services due to the faster proposal evaluation and project funding process
 - *European-scale networks* between SMEs, large companies and academia that will facilitate take-up and deployment of technologies
 - A long term commitment from public authorities (7 years)

What's in it for me? (2/2)

- ... in particular
 - Single and simpler procedure as compared to EUREKA
 - shorter time to contract
 - Single project, ensuring technical coherence in the same time-frame
 - contracting/administrative handling of costs at local/national level
